

Ecology of Lake and River Ecosystems Trent University

Graduate PhD positions are available to contribute to on-going ecological research on lakes and rivers in the Laboratory of Freshwater Ecology at Trent University in Peterborough, Ontario. Research for these positions could range from foodweb responses to environmental stress to landscape studies of carbon and nutrients. Field work for these positions could include the Great Lakes basin, central Ontario in cottage country and the Experimental Lakes Area in northwestern Ontario. These graduate positions are funded at the PhD level but we will consider exceptional MSc candidates who are interested in transferring to the PhD. Positions will be based at Trent University in Peterborough, Ontario as part of the Environmental and Life Sciences Graduate Program (<http://www.trentu.ca/els/>) and begin in 2019 or 2020 (Winter, Spring or Fall).
